



Devens Urban Assault Course Construction Devens, MA

Charter was contracted to construct an Urban Assault Course located on the South Post at Fort Devens, MA. The facility will provide a platoon and smaller units an urban operations training facility for active Army, Reserve and National Guard units in tactics, techniques and procedures required for training in an urban environment under simulated conditions. The Urban Assault Course will provide individual, team squad and platoon level training on urban assault and features an automated target system as well as targets in buildings.

The scope of the Urban Assault Course consists of the construction of the following stations:

- ▶Station 1 – Individual and Team Trainer
- ▶Station 2 – Squad and Platoon Task Trainer
- ▶Station 3 – Grenadier Gunnery Trainer
- ▶Station 4 – Urban Offense/Defense Trainer (a three story masonry block building built on a poured in place concrete foundation utilizing precast concrete planks for the floors).

Supporting facilities include:

- ▶Operations/Storage Building - Construction of a single story masonry block building built on a poured in place concrete foundation, which includes a standing seam metal roof, HVAC and interior finishes, and
- ▶Observation Tower

Site improvements include:

- ▶Site grading
- ▶Range limit markers
- ▶Area lighting
- ▶Electrical to target emplacements
- ▶Vehicle parking lot

Work started in October 2007 with an estimated completion of July 2008.
